This is a pragmatic track that prepares the students for effective communication in speaking and writing. Students learn how to apply their linguistic skills in the field of translation and in a capstone project or in a 5000-word research. The capstone project can take many forms, from an approved internship, a study abroad experience, to the translation of an article in a field chosen by the student in consultation with the advisor. If the student writes a senior thesis in his or her major, he / she has the option to write a short version of the paper in Spanish or can translate it in Spanish, depending upon the complexity of the project.
