Westminster College will accept credit hours of grades "C" or better at full value with a maximum of 61 semester hours being applied to the Bachelor's Degree.

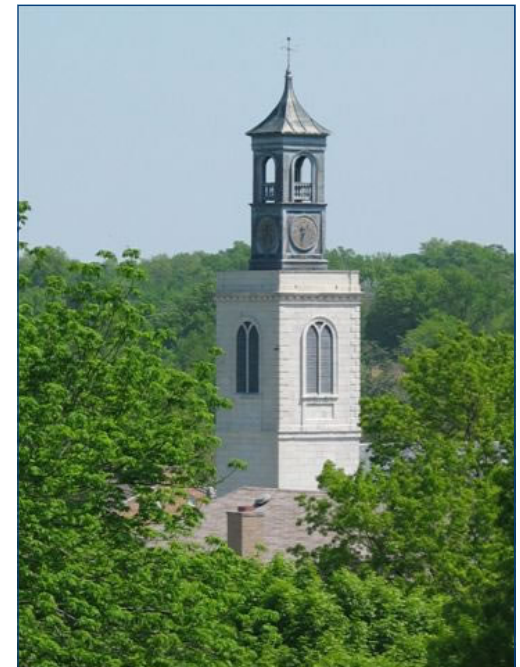
There are no restrictions for transfer students regarding privileges and benefits including financial assistance; student government leadership; academic honors; and organizational memberships.
